



Environmental Policy Statement

Environmental protection is a fundamental principle at Motorclean Limited.

One of our main priorities is to create a positive environmental image for Motorclean Limited. Taking into account the ecological and legislative framework conditions, environmental pollution is to be minimised, as far as is reasonably practicable, both during and at the end of a material's lifespan, so conserving valuable resources.

This will be aimed at the reduction of emissions to the atmosphere and to the soil and water table. We undertake to adhere to the conditions of our local council authorisations, in respect of the Environmental Protection Act, at all times, and to continue to seek to utilise low impact materials, to recycle and to appropriately segregate and dispose of waste in collaboration with our customers.

Motorclean Limited, and in particular management staff, will be responsible for monitoring the use of energy, material resources and disposal, and where necessary to recommend proposals for reduction.

Motorclean Limited will actively participate in any recycling strategies put in place by the customer whilst working on their premises.

Motorclean Limited will also refrain from washing vehicles in areas that do not have the correct drainage facilities to capture the effluent that is being washed off the vehicles.

Motorclean Limited is striving towards accreditation to ISO 14001 which will operate alongside our ISO 9001 accreditation.

The overall responsibility for maintaining the Environmental Policy will be with the Health & Safety and Environmental Co-ordinator and the Directors who, along with our consultants and suppliers, will carry out activities to inform, train and communicate the policy to our managers and operators.
